

Patriotic Star-Spangled Cake Pops

Looking for a show-stopping dessert for the 4th of July or any patriotic party? These festive red, white, and blue cake pops are easy to make, fun to decorate, and sure to be a hit with guests of all ages. Perfect for barbecues, picnics, or party favors!

Ingredients

- 1 box white cake mix
- Red and blue food coloring
- 1 cup white frosting
- 24 oz white melting chocolate
- Cake pop sticks
- Patriotic sprinkles

Instructions

1. **Bake the Cake:** Prepare the cake mix according to the package instructions. Let it cool completely.
2. **Crumble the Cake:** Break the cake into fine crumbs using your hands or a fork.
3. **Mix with Frosting:** Gradually mix in frosting until a dough-like consistency is reached.
4. **Add the Color:** Divide the mixture into 3 parts—leave one white, color one red, and one blue.
5. **Form Cake Balls:** Combine bits of each color and roll into balls. Place on a parchment-lined baking sheet.
6. **Insert Sticks and Freeze:** Insert cake pop sticks and freeze for 20–30 minutes until firm.
7. **Melt and Color the Chocolate:** Melt white chocolate and optionally color portions red and blue.
8. **Dip and Decorate:** Dip each pop in melted chocolate and immediately decorate with sprinkles.
9. **Let Set:** Stand upright in a holder or Styrofoam block and let the chocolate harden before serving.

Tip: These are great to wrap in cellophane and give as party favors!
